### **Applicable law**

Dutch law is applicable to every assignment and all obligations arising from it. The District Court in Amsterdam has exclusive jurisdiction.

### **Complaints**

Pursuant to article 46 of the Act of Advocates (*"Advocatenwet"*), the advocates are subject to disciplinary rules with regard to any acts or omissions in violation of the care they must exercise in their capacity of advocates towards those whose interests they are representing or should be representing as such with regard to violations of the provisions under or pursuant to this act and the Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing Prevention Act (*"Wet ter voorkoming van witwassen en financieren van terrorisme"*), the regulations of the Netherlands Bar and with regard to any act or omissions that do not befit a proper a respectable advocate. These disciplinary rules are at first instance exercised by the Board of Discipline and on appeal, also in the highest instance, by the disciplinary court.

VEEM.Legal is not affiliated with the Disputes Committee (*"Geschillencommissie"*). VEEM.Legal has an internal Complaints Procedure. On the website of VEEM.Legal you can find more information about the Complaints Procedure, for example how a complaint can be submitted and how it will be handled. VEEM.Legal will respond to complaints as soon as possible and make every effort to find a satisfactory solution.



### **Professional liability insurance**
